## Pete's paid charity gig

**MYSTERIOUS** Girl singer Peter Andre was paid thousands to busk for 15 minutes for the homeless.

The ex-*I'm A Celeb* star was praised for performing for charity Shelter in London last month.

But the pop-up gig only took £260 through a cash collection and payments via debit cards and mobiles.

Andre, 44, an ex-husband of Katie Price, was being paid by a building society to promote electronic giving to charity.

Andre's representatives said after the gig he voluntarily gave a "substantial" amount to Shelter and "supports six or seven chosen charities and does everything for them free."
